Spotlight is on stage. "Me" dances into it. (Emphasize the "I" and "Me" throughout the skit.)

Spotlight comes on empty space. Satan speaks from behind a divider or curtain.

You don't need to wish upon a star, just trust in me and you will have it all! (*Chuckles*, "Hee, Hee")

Music comes on playing O, Holy Night. A group of three carollers stand together as a spotlight appears on them.

SECOND LADY: Yes, we need each other and even when we are alone, God, still is always with us, to comfort and assure us that He has everything under control. After all, He is the one in charge! He provides for all our needs.

THIRD LADY: And best of all, He sent Jesus into the world to be the way, the truth and the life! He is the Light of the world! The true Morning Star! Oh, if only the world knew about this so they could believe in Him as their true Saviour!

(Ladies smile at each other as if the "light" goes on in their minds.)

TOGETHER: (in unison)

We need to tell them before it's too late! *They leave in different directions singing:* "Go tell it on the mountain, over the hills and everywhere, Go tell it on the mountain that Jesus Christ is born."
